REQUEST FOR APPROVAL OF THE PEORIA CITY/COUNTY LANDFILL
November 16, 2022, Regular Landfill Meeting Minutes

Van Winkle motioned to approve, seconded by Fox; approved
with a unanimous verbal vote.

AGENDA ITEMS

ITEM NO. 1 REPORT FROM FOTH INFRASTRUCTURE & ENVIRONMENT, LLC

A. Monthly Update

Gabehart reported a leachate haul of about 8000 tons overall. Financially, they were right on budget for the year's spending plan.

B. Signature Approvals

Gabehart discussed the signature approval requests.

The semiannual pretreatment report, a summary of all the leachate that was charged to the Greater Peoria Sanitary District over the past 6 months and runs through January 20th.

The Clean Air Act permit program semiannual reports are due on January 31st. Gabehart said they are reviewing them as there have been a few format changes, but mentioned it is the same basic information for monitoring reports.

The DNR Abandoned Mines Land Reclamations Division reached out to Foth regarding an infrastructure bill that allows them funding to cap and close several shafts and portals around the state. There is an application to allow them access to the property and the areas they inspected are eligible for repair. The repair includes excavating around the shafts and portals, putting in gravel, and bringing native soil to plant in the area. Gabehart clarified that from his understanding, the request is just for access to the properties and not for any financial assistance from the committee. Morris asked if Foth had any reservations regarding the request. Gabehart responded, saying there are no concerns with the current request.

Riggerbach motioned to approve signatures, seconded by Fox; approved with a unanimous verbal vote.

C. Profiled Waste Approvals

Gabehart explained Foth does not require any approvals for this month.

ITEM NO. 2 REPORT FROM PUBLIC WORKS ADMINISTRATION

A. Landfill Monthly Budget Report

Schoonover reported that for the month of November revenues were just under \$43,000 compared to the budget of \$40,000. Expenditures were \$26,100 compared to the budget of nearly \$39,000, so for the month the committee is \$16,700 under budget. Year to date is on pace at \$440,000 in revenue with the total budget being \$480,000. Expenditures are at \$570,000 compared to a budget of \$466,000. Overall, the committee is currently \$130,000 under budget and the cash balance at the end of the year is \$206,000.

B. FY2023 Budget Approval

Van Winkle motioned to approve the 2023 Budget, seconded by Riggerbach. Fox counter voted with explanation; the motion to approve the budget was declined.

Fox mentioned the overall reserve fund that includes details regarding targets and plans for the year. He requested the committee have more time to review that information before approving the 2023 budget.

Morris motioned to approve the delay of the 2023 Budget approval. Approved with a unanimous verbal vote.

ITEM NO. 3 REPORT FROM WASTE MANAGEMENT-Ian Johnson

A. Monthly Activity Reports

Johnson reported receiving all weekly random load checks at the Landfill with no issues.

B. Signature Approvals

Johnson referred to Item 2 of Waste Management's action, requesting signature approvals for a Gas CQA report to send in the application during the second week of January. He mentioned Foth reviewed the report and included their comments in the action.

Fox motioned to approve signatures, seconded by Riggerbach; approved with a unanimous verbal vote.

Morris mentioned concern with the communication procedures for closing the landfill due to inclement weather. He requested that closures be discussed with the Committee and the City of Peoria.

ITEM NO 4. REPORT FROM GFL

A. Monthly Activity Reports

GFL is finalizing construction drawings and plans to bid in January or February. They plan to begin cell construction of mass excavation as soon as weather permits.

B. Signature Approvals

GFL requested to defer the signature approvals for the wetland mitigation and wetland bank until the next meeting.
